New York State **Senator John Marchi** graduated from St. John's School of Law in 1949. He was a World War II veteran who was first elected to the Senate in 1957. He served until his retirement in 2006, having one of the longest-serving careers of an elected official in the country. Senator Marchi was a tireless leader and advocate for the people of Staten Island. In 1971, St. John's University awarded him an honorary Doctor of Laws degree and in 2006 St. John's Law School and the Law School Alumni Association presented him with the John J. Murphy Award, which is given to a graduate in recognition of distinguished service to the public, the profession and the Rule of Law.
